



## October 17 Household Hazardous Waste Collection --What to Bring and What Not To--

### YES, bring these items, which Perry County Recycling will collect as you enter:

- Large batteries (car, boat, tool, etc.)
- Motor oil, transmission fluid and hydraulic fluid

### YES, bring these items, which Hoff Brothers LP Gas Co. will collect as you enter:

- Compressed gas cylinders such as propane, acetylene and CO<sub>2</sub>

### YES, bring corrosive, toxic, flammable or reactive items such as these:

- Oil based paint (not latex)
- Aerosols
- Antifreeze
- Small batteries
- Acid based material (ex. battery acid, drain cleaner, pool chemicals, photographic chemicals)
- Caustic based material (ex. bleach)
- Flammable liquids
- Oxidizers (ex. chlorine tablets)
- Pesticides/Poisons/ Herbicides

### NO, do not bring these, but here's what you can do with some of them:

- Business waste, controlled substances, biohazard or medical waste, temperature-controlled substances and sharps (ex. needles, razors).
- Latex paint: Pour onto paper or cardboard, let dry and put in trash.
- Asbestos: Contact Missouri DNR for nearest approved sanitary landfill (presently there is one in Dexter).
- Fluorescent bulbs: Lowes Home Improvement Warehouse collects these.
- Fire extinguishers, fire alarms, smoke detectors: Some manufacturers will take them back.
- Mercury items (ex. thermometers, thermostats): Currently it is cost prohibitive to process these.
- Explosives: Call ATF in Cape Girardeau 573-331-7300.
- Drugs/Medicine: Do not flush drugs down the toilet; take them to Perryville Police Dept. and deposit in the green box in the lobby. No liquids, needles or aerosols, such as inhalers.
- Tires: Recycle them through your tire dealer when you buy new ones.
- Appliances: Take to Perry County Recycling Center. No fees. Do not have to remove Freon.
- Electronics: Take to Perry County Recycling Center. No fees except for TV's, which contain hazardous metals.
