DOUBLE CHECK YOUR PLASTICS

REMEMBER: The recycling center only accepts NO. 1 and NO. 2 plastics. All other numbered plastics should be placed in garbage. Look for the appropriate symbol to ensure your plastic is recyclable.

WE CAN RECYCLE



CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard (non wax-coated). Remove all packing material. Paste Board cereal, tissue or other boxes. Wax liners must be removed. Flatten boxes.



OFFICE PAPER & JUNK MAIL

White office paper, colored paper, computer paper, notebook paper, junk mail, envelopes, manila folder, legal pads, sticky notes and shredded paper are acceptable items.



ALUMINUM

Please drain cans. Cans may be crushed.



STEEL FOOD CANS

Rinse clean. paper labels are okay. Place lid inside can and pinch closed.



MAGAZINES, NEWSPAPER INSERTS AND BOOKS

Includes hard and softback books. Items must be dry.



#1 & #2 PLASTIC ONLY

This includes plastic bottles, such as milk jugs, water, soda and detergent bottles. REMOVE CAPS AND THROW IN THE GARBAGE. Bottles should be rinsed clean.



GLASS

Dispose of plastic lids in garbage. Glass must be rinsed clean. Metal lids may be recycled with all other steel items.



NEWSPAPER

Products must be dry.

- USED COOKING, HYDRAULIC, MOTOR AND DIESEL OIL (PERRYVILLE PUBLIC WORKS ALSO ACCEPTS USED COOKING OIL)
- BATTERIES
- TRANSMISSION FLUID
- SCRAP METAL
- APPLIANCES
- E-WASTE (TELEVISIONS, COMPUTER MONITORS AND OTHER ELECTRONICS. FEES APPLY FOR TV/MONITORS)

WE CANNOT ACCEPT...

- PLASTIC LIDS, BAGS OR HANGERS
- WRAPPING PAPER
- WINDOWS
- JAR CANDLES AND VASES
- CERAMIC/PORCELAIN
- LIGHT BULBS
- ANTIFREEZE
- STYROFOAM (SEE ATLAS EPS FOR RECYCLING OPTIONS)
- GREASY PIZZA BOXES
- NEEDLES
- YARD WASTE
- JUICE OR OTHER WAX-COVERED DRINK BOXES
- YOGURT CUPS
- #3 - #7 PLASTIC CONTAINERS (SUCH AS FRUIT CUPS; COTTAGE CHEESE, MARGARINE, OR SOUR CREAM CONTAINERS; MEDICATION BOTTLES)
- FAST FOOD PLASTIC LIDS, STRAWS OR CUPS
- DELI TAKE OUT CONTAINERS
- ALUMINUM FOIL



Please help...

Non-recyclable items can contaminate entire loads of recyclable items, forcing staff to dispose of what would have been otherwise reusable materials. Make sure recyclables are properly sorted and cleaned, and dispose of all trash in a proper receptacle. Do not bring trash to recycling center. Dispose of it at home.

REMEMBER...WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT.



Make recycling happen by preparing your recyclables as requested. What can be recycled and how these materials have to be prepared is determined by the businesses that make products from recycled materials. Manufacturers require clean & contaminate-free materials to make new products. UNSORTED OR IMPROPERLY PREPARED MATERIALS WILL BE DISPOSED OF IN A LANDFILL.
