AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND REPLACE ORDINANCE NO. 07-02, AS AMENDED FEBRUARY 2, 2017 FOR SPECIAL USE PERMITS FOR USE OF COUNTY ROADS BY UTILITY VEHICLES AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTIONS 304.013, 304.032, & 304.033 RSMO AND AS ADOPTED BY THE PERRY COUNTY COMMISSION

Whereas, the state of Missouri has determined County Commissions have the authority to issue special use permits for the operation of all-terrain, utility, and recreational vehicles on county roads; and

Whereas, County Commissions may establish fees for issuance of such special use permits; and

Whereas, the Perry County Commission has determined Perry County Ordinance 07-02 places an excessive and unnecessary burden on the citizens of the County; and

Whereas, Sections 304.013, 304.032, & 304.033 RSMo provides for the authority of local law enforcement to ensure the safety of local roadways under State Law; and

Whereas, all Perry County Roads are accessible to and for use of, utility, and recreational vehicles (UTV & RHOV) as defined by Sec. 301.010 RSMo, and

Whereas, the County Commission desires to repeal Ordinance 07-02 related to the issuance of special use permits for Perry County residents, effective March 1, 2021; and

Whereas, the County Commission establishes, that in lieu of an established fee all all-terrain, utility and recreational vehicles which are properly placed on the owner's personal property tax assessment list are considered permitted and allowed on Perry County Roads, and

Whereas, the County requires that owners of all-terrain, utility or recreational vehicles shall maintain a copy of the current tax waiver or receipt, listing the device, be maintained in the glove or storage compartment of the vehicle; and

Whereas, the Commission waives all back taxes and penalties on devices not previously listed on the owner's assessment list prior to March 1, 2021 for the purpose of issuing the permit only; and


Whereas, the County authorizes a prorated refund of permit fees to any resident having a current and valid permit as of March 1, 2021;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Perry County Commission:

That Ordinance 07-02 is hereby repealed; and

That this Ordinance is adopted on this 28th day of December, 2020, by action of the Perry County Commission, to become effective as of the 1st day of March, 2021.


