

PUBLIC NOTICE
PERRY COUNTY DUST CONTROL PROGRAM

The Perry County Commission is accepting applications for dust control oil on the County's Road system through Friday, April 25, 2025. The following requirements govern this year's application program:

1. All applicants are to sign up in person at the Perry County Administration Building, 321 N. Main St., Ste. 2, in Perryville.
2. Applicants shall provide their name, address, phone number, road number and approximate roadway footage to be treated.
*There is a minimum of 100 CONSECUTIVE feet per roadway.
3. In past years of the program's operation; maintenance preparation, grading, pothole repair, and application cost of oil and chips have exceeded the amount of monies collected and said cost have been absorbed by the County. Cost for 2024 is ten dollars (\$10.00) per foot.
4. Payment will be due upon measurement verification by the Perry County Road & Bridge Department.
5. Payment must be received prior to the application of oil and chips

* Roadways will be treated with up to two layers oil with a coat of chips lightly applied over each layer.

* If property owners who have had oil and chip applications in the past do not participate in this year's program, it may be necessary to grade some of these roads back to gravel.

It is anticipated that some road work, including grading and crushed stone placement, may be necessary at some of the proposed application sites.

The deadline for signup is Friday, April 25, 2025, at 5 p.m. This will be the final date for signup, with no exceptions. Questions concerning this program should be addressed to the Perry County Commission at 573-547-4242.
